I. *Programme*

The Commonwealth Legal Education Association (CLEA – Asia India) is pleased to announce its Summer School - 2015 which will be organised by CLEA jointly with European College of Law, UK.

II. *Program Details*

The CLEA- ECL Summer School will be attended by students from selected Commonwealth countries including Ghana, Bangladesh, India and Sri Lanka. The Summer School will be held at UK from 25-29 September, 2015. Ten students from India will participate in the CLEA- ECL Summer School, 2015. The selection of ten students will be on the basis of a Research Article Competition. CLEA (Asia-India) and ECL invite all interested students to take part in the Research Article Writing Competition and win a chance to attend Summer School in UK. The details of the competitions are attached herewith.

Rules and Guidelines for the CLEA Research Article Competition

Eligibility Criteria

- The Competition is open to the students who are pursuing their 5 year Undergraduate Degree in Law in any university across India.
- Co-authorship is not allowed.

Guidelines for Submission

- The Research Article must be written in English only.
- Only *original* Research Articles will be considered for the purpose of competition. No part of it should have been published earlier nor should it be under consideration for publication or a contest elsewhere in India or abroad. Moreover any form of plagiarism or copyright infringement will result in disqualification of the Research Article. The organisers will not be responsible for the act of plagiarism/ copyright infringement.
- Your name/Institution's name or any sort of identification mark shall not be found in any part of the Research Article.

Registration

- Registration form is to be sent on or before 15th July 2015 to **cleasummerschool@gmail.com**
- The registration form must be signed and sealed by the Head of the Institution/University. In case of unavailability of the Head of the institution any senior faculty may sign the same.
- The registration form should be sent along with the registration fee of Rs.1500/- as demand draft in favour of **The Commonwealth Legal Education Association payable at Delhi** or copy bank transfer challan (Commonwealth Legal Education Association, AC No: 14780100005959, the Federal Bank, Mayur Vihar, New Delhi, IFS Code: FDRI0001478) . Kindly mention your name and college name behind the demand draft and on the copy of the challan.
- A copy of your College Identity Card also needs to be attached along with the registration form.
- The forms must reach the office of the organizers before 15th July 2015. Address: Dr. Lisa P Lukose, 27 A, Una Enclave, Mayur Vihar Phase 1, Delhi -110091.

Length of the Research Article

- The submission shall consist of an abstract, introduction, main body of Research Article which may be divided into various headings and subheadings and bibliography.
- An abstract should not be more than 200 words exclusive of title and 4 keywords

- The Research Article should not be more than 5000 words (excluding footnotes and abstract)

Format requirement

- The font size of the Research Article shall be 12 points in Times New Roman.
- Title shall be in bold, subtitle shall be italicized.
- The line space shall be 1.5
- Footnotes must conform to the *JILI* rules of Footnoting. (Pl refer the same at <http://www.ili.ac.in/footnoting12.pdf>)
- The font size of the footnote shall be 10 points in Times New Roman and single spaced.
- The page number shall be included as a footer in the form “page 3 of 5” on the right side of each page.
- On the left side of the footer allotted code number “01CLEA2015” should be mentioned.

Submission

- The participants should send the following attachments via E-mail. The file name of the Research Article should be in format Code assigned, e.g. 01CLEA2015.docx
- Research Article should only be in MS Word format of .docx.
- Cover page should only contain the code assigned at the time of registration.
- Identity of the candidate shall not be disclosed anywhere.
- Research Article must be mailed only to lisrobin@gmail.com, with the code number of the participant.

Topic for the Research Article

- The Broad Theme for the Research Article is “Transnational Legal Education: Prospect and Challenges”. Every participant has to choose a specific sub theme from the given broad theme and to attempt a Research Article. For example: Constitutional Law: Transnational Perspective or Global Administrative Law: Transnational Angle or Intellectual Property Rights Law: Need for a Comparative Law Teaching and the like. Organisers expect that the participants would cover a variety of subtopics including but not limited to arbitration, Taxation, Business and Commercial Laws, Insurance, Criminal Law, Human Rights, Environmental Law, Company Law, Family Law, Sports Law, Entertainment Law, Legal Research, etc.

Declaration of Results & Prizes

- All entries received for the competition will be evaluated by a Screening Committee and the top 50 entries will be sent to the Jury for the selection of the winners.
- The selected 10 Research Articles' authors will be selected for participate in the Summer School to be held at UK from 25-29 September 2015
- The selected students need to pay a sum of Rs.10000/- as registration fee for the summer school. The Organising committee of summer school will take care of your boarding and lodging in UK.
- The name of the winners will be announced on 03rd August 2015.
- Certificate of Participation will be awarded to all the participants.

- Registration Closing date: 15th July 2015 (5.00 pm)
- Last date for receiving the submission through E-mail is 31 July 2015 (5.00 pm)
- Result announcement :3rd August 2015
- Date for payment of non-refundable Registration fee for Summer School: 05th August 2015
- Summer School date : 25-29 September 2015
- Late submissions shall not be considered for any purposes.

Publication

- Top ten selected Research Articles will be published in the form of an edited book with an ISBN number or in an international Journal with ISSN Number. The list of these selected Research Articles will be intimated by e-mail. Author of the selected Research Articles will also be given a certificate of publication.

Registration Fees

- Every participant of the Research Article competition has to submit fee of INR 1500 along with the registration form on or before the last date of 15 July, 2015.
- Non-refundable Registration fee for Summer School Rs.10000/- (only for selected participants)

Miscellaneous

- The administration of the contest for the purpose of determining the eligibility of a participant or Research Article, standard of Research

Article, evaluation of Research Article s and awarding of the prizes is within the sole and absolute discretion of the organisers.

- The organisers assume no responsibility for delayed or incomplete entries or technical malfunction or server problems, traffic congestion or a combination thereof or delayed couriers or speed post-delivery.
- Certificates will be posted at the respective authors university address only. The organisers take no responsibility for postal delay or damage or returned post.
- The rights in all submitted Research Articles will vest with organisers till announcement of the result.
- The rights in the selected Research Articles will vest with organisers even after the declaration of the result. The same shall not be used or published elsewhere.

Jury

- The jury will be constituted by the organisers consisting of Academicians, Supreme Court Judges and Senior Lawyers.
