Training of Mediators (Forty Hours)

Mediation is fast becoming an accepted method for Alternative Dispute Resolution. The Government of India is also promoting mediation and has also amended the Code of Civil Procedure to encourage settlement of disputes through mediation. The Delhi High Court, Punjab and Haryana High Court, Allahabad High Court, Karnataka High Court, Bombay High Court, etc. have already set up mediation centres at the level of district courts and also in the High Court(s), where mediation is being done successfully. Thus the perception for settlement of commercial and other disputes through Conciliation/Mediation is growing. The Delhi Dispute Resolution Society started by Govt. of National Capital Territory has also started eight Mediation Centres for resolution of commercial disputes, family disputes, neighbourhood disputes, etc. Thus there is a growing need for trained mediators.

The International Centre for Alternative Dispute Resolution (ICADR) is an autonomous organisation working under the aegis of Supreme Court of India, with its Headquarters at New Delhi and Regional Centres at Hyderabad and Bengaluru. It has been established to promote, popularise and propagate alternative dispute resolution methods to facilitate early resolution of disputes so as to reduce the burden of arrears in Courts. The Chief Justice of India is the Ex-Officio Chairperson of ICADR.

The International Centre for Alternative Dispute Resolution (ICADR) will be conducting an Intensive Training Programme in Mediation for Five Days (40 Hours) from 27th to 30th June & 1st July, 2017 (Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, Friday and Saturday) from 09:30 A.M. to 05:30 P.M. The training will be provided by qualified Master Trainers certified by the Internationally renowned Institution viz. Centre for Effective Dispute Resolution (CEDR), London. Persons who successfully complete the training programme will be issued Certificates.
