CALL FOR PAPER

Eligibility

- Students, academicians, bureaucrats, professionals, researchers etc.

Word limit and other guidelines

- 3500-5000 words
- Font style- Times New Roman
- Font size- 12
- Font size of footnotes- 10
- Line spacing- 1.5
- Line spacing for footnotes- 1
- Citations style must adhere to the bluebook citation format, 19th edition.
- The paper must contain the title of the paper along with author name and affiliation. It must also be particular about the sub theme of the paper.

Registration fees

The registration fee including registration kit, lunch, tea break, etc., excluding the accommodation, is as follows:

Students

- (1) For Paper Presenters - Rs 1,500/-
- (2) For Participant - Rs 1,000/-

Professionals

- (1) For Paper Presenters - Rs 2,000/-
- (2) For Participant - Rs 1,500/-

Presenters/Participants need to send the scanned copy of the identity card/Aadhar card with the receipt of payment acknowledgement received from the bank after successful remittance of money to symposium.iljcc@gmail.com .

Presentation Guidelines

- The presentation is restricted to a 10 minutes + 2 minutes time format for rebuttal round. Participants can make presentation in .ppt or .pptx format compatible with MS Office 2007, which is to be carried by the participants in a pen drive.
- The selected author(s) must also carry 4 hard copies of their paper, for submission to the panel member, along with I-Card of the concerned university/ college.

How to submit

- The submission may be mailed to symposium.iljcc@gmail.com in Microsoft Word (.doc or .docx) format.
- The file name must contain the name of the author(s) along with affiliation.

Co-Authorship

Co-Authorship up to a maximum of three authors is allowed.

Publication

Twenty best papers will be shortlisted for publication in a special issue on the official website of DROIT PENALE: INDIAN LAW JOURNAL ON CRIME AND CRIMINOLOGY (ONLINE) ISSN 2456-7280.
