Submissions are invited for the following:

- 1. Articles (5000-10000 words)**
- 2. Essays (3000-6000 words)**
- 3. Notes & Comments (2000-5000 words)**
- 4. Book Review (1000-2000 words)**

Deadline for submission of manuscripts for the forthcoming issue is February 28, 2018.

All submissions must adhere to the following guidelines:

1. The submitted manuscript should not be published previously or under consideration for publication.
2. Footnoting must be mandatorily done according to the 19th Edition Harvard Bluebook Citation.
3. The font must be Times New Roman with size 14, for headings, and 12 for the remaining body with footnotes in Times New Roman, size 10.
4. Line Spacing -1.5 and 1.0 (footnotes) and a margin of 1" on all sides.
5. The submission must contain an abstract of no more than 300 words.
6. Co-Authorship is permitted to a maximum of two authors.
7. Plagiarism will be viewed with zero tolerance.
