- The case comment must be submitted in .doc/.docx format only with 12 pt font size, 10 pt foot note size, Margins should be of 2.54cm on all sides, 1.5 indent and 1.5 line spacing in Times New Roman Font.
- The word limit for the case comment is 3000 words.
- The certificates of participation will be awarded to all the participants.
