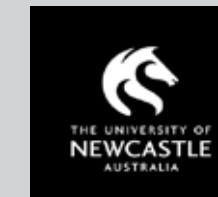

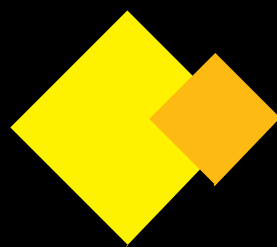

THE INTERNATIONAL INSURANCE CONFERENCE

The insurance business plays a critical and sustainable role in the economic development of a country. The economic reforms in India and globally have furthered healthy competition among the national and multinational companies to capture untapped markets and resulted in rapid surge of economic activities including the capital formation, risk distribution, social security, protection against uncertainties and catastrophes. The Indian insurance sector has shown its clout during the turbulences in US and other countries because of the economic crisis resulting from subprime lending, natural calamities and terrorist activities.

The insurance industry in India has remained unshaken even during turbulences in the global economy because of strong fundamental practices followed under the aegis of the Insurance Regulatory and Development Authority of India (IRDAI). The effective and efficient monitoring of the insurance business by IRDAI has provided a healthy platform for the growth of the insurance industry vis-à-vis the total economy of the country.

The insurance business is governed by legislations, allied enactments, regulations and notifications issued by IRDAI from time to time. The proactive role of IRDAI motivated by the guidelines of International Association of Insurance Supervisors is contributing for the positive growth of insurance business and ultimately the nation's economy. However, with the changing time and the challenges posed by the global economy, there is every need to re-visit, rectify and mitigate the gaps in the regulatory legal regime and economy governing the insurance business.

CALL FOR PAPERS

The International Conference on Insurance Law and Regulation: Global Practices, will be held from 1st to 3rd February 2019 at ICFAI Law School, IFHE, Hyderabad, India. The conference invites full length scholarly papers in the emerging areas of Insurance law, regulation and practices. Contributions are invited on theoretical, methodological, and empirical investigations with emphasis on insurance law, regulation and practices, including but not limited to the themes of the conference. The themes of the conference are only indicative. We invite and encourage papers from other

Abstracts should be sent to incon.inslaw@ifheindia.org by 25th November 2018 which will be reviewed by a review panel. After the approval of the abstract, a code will be assigned for each paper which shall be intimated to the participants after which they can register for the conference.

Co-authorship up to two authors is permissible for each paper.

GUIDELINES FOR PAPER SUBMISSION

The full papers should preferably be formatted in the APA Style. It should be written in less than 6,000 words, including tables, exhibits, references and appendices.

The manuscript should begin with a separate title page containing: the Paper Title, Author(s)' affiliation and e-mail ID, Abstract (Max 300 words), and five keywords. The rest of the manuscript should not contain any author identifying information. The authors should submit their abstracts/ full-papers through e-mail only.
