During their course of life in Maharas they started developing misunderstandings between them and subsequently Mr. Sharan parted ways with Mr. Shyam on 18/08/2018 without any further intimation.

Several attempts were made by Mr. Shyam to contact Sharan, but went in vain. As a result, Shyam tried filing a case but was not allowed to do it as per Dravidian Laws.

With all other efforts, Mr. Shyam approached an NGO named "SMILE LIVES" on

22/09/2018. After consulting the panel of advocates, he filed a writ petition against the Union of Dravidian in the Hon'ble Apex Court seeking the recognition of validity of same sex marriage and gender equality based on the recent judgment dated 06/09/2018 relating to decriminalization of Section 377 of the Dravidian Penal Code.
