- Abstract required with manuscript: 200-300 words.
- Text Format: Times New Roman, Size 12, Line Spacing 1.5, Justified.
- Citation Format: Bluebook (20<sup>th</sup> ed.), Times New Roman, Size 10, Line Spacing 1, Justified.
- Co-authorship is allowed up to two authors.
- All the submissions must be the original work of the author(s) and should not be under consideration for any other submission.
- All the submissions are to be mailed at [rfmlr@rgnul.ac.in](mailto:rfmlr@rgnul.ac.in) with the subject "Submission for RFMLR 6.2" latest by **April 30<sup>th</sup>, 2019**.
- Each author is allowed to submit a maximum of 1 submission.
- The manuscript should be accompanied with a covering letter specifying the author's name, designation, institute, contact number and e-mail.
- The author(s) bear sole responsibility for the accuracy of facts, opinions and views stated in the submitted Manuscript.
- Plagiarism limit of 12% should be strictly adhered to.
