Unitedworld School of Law is organizing a one day National Seminar on “A Paradigm Shift of Right to Privacy and Artificial Intelligence in The Contemporary Digitalized World” on 12<sup>th</sup> October 2019. The Seminar endeavors to invite views from distinct sections of the stakeholders, academicians, research scholars and students on the legal issues related to the right to privacy and the associated vital facets.

Right to Privacy has been considered to be the most sacrosanct in the age of 21<sup>st</sup> century and has a direct linkage with dignity and liberty of a person. Right to privacy is a perfect combination of constitutional, customary and common law dispersed over diverse legal meadows. Data Protection can be comprehended as a set of legal framework for guaranteeing the protection of one’s personal data. Rapid digitalization of the products and services has turned out to be the key element in the present age and resulted to several challenges. For the regulation of the same various data protection legislations are passed by distinct states. India also didn’t lag behind and passed Data Protection Bill based on Sri Krishna Committee Report. But the status of the legal

framework of Data Protection in India is at a very nascent stage since of its existence in the form of bill from its inception due to the dearth of an express legislation regarding the protection of personal data. It is easily deduced that in the present society the role of data is ubiquitous and the processing of our data is done without our prior permission and usually the consent is given by the people in haste because of the extensive terms & conditions. All the existing challenges entail the instant consideration of the state to ensure the informational privacy of individuals. Data protection has evolved itself to be as most considerable domains in contemporary society.

In past few decades, laws pertaining to privacy have developed rapidly and the effect of the advancement of Artificial Intelligence (AI) are already being experienced in many sectors of the society. It has been intensely influencing our lives and is of massive blessings ranging from performance profits to extraordinary enhancements of the great existence. However, the inimitable characteristic of AI and the manner AI is progressing encompasses social, moral, political and legal implications.

The conference presents first considered session at the minutiae of the right to privacy and the various facets associated to it. The second session shall provide the preface of data protection laws and its implication in the society. The session will also take the coverage of the challenges of informational privacy and the data protection bill. Third and the last session shall put the controversy of Artificial Intelligence and will delve to the Srikrishna Committee Report for analyzing the privacy dimensions of AI. The session will also address the discussion on the pros and cons of AI and will cover the issues of 'Crypto currency' and 'Block box' algorithms.

5. Abstract shall not exceed to maximum of 250-300 words.
  6. Full paper must be of 3000-4000 words (exclusive of footnotes/endnotes/bibliography).
  7. The main text should be in Times New Roman with font size 12 and line spacing of 1.5. Footnotes should be in Times New Roman with font size 10 and line spacing of 1.0.
  8. There should be one inch margin on all the four sides.
  9. Citation Style: Bluebook, 19<sup>th</sup> Edition.
  10. Abstract as well as Full Paper shall be submitted both in pdf and MS Word and shall be submitted to [carcl@uwsl.edu.in](mailto:carcl@uwsl.edu.in)
