## About Green Governance Initiative

The Green Governance Initiative (GGI) is a youth-based policy research think-tank that works through a collaboration with elected representatives, policymakers, and administrators, to ensure the effective implementation of the “**United Nations' 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development by incorporating it in India's Vision 2030**”.

GGI aims in facilitating the outreach of various social welfare schemes to the grassroots level through the concept of Constituency Development through UN SDGs. The organisation also identifies potential inputs for sustainable and achievable outcomes, while ensuring optimum use of minimum resources. We further look forward to build a holistic synergy between top-down model of governance by collaborating with private investors, technologists, policy-makers, thinkers amongst various others. We also seek new innovations along with bottom-up interventions, which includes sustainable development approaches through the identification of actual needs, issues and aspirations via a mechanism which begins from grassroots community thereby transforming good governance to green governance.

At GGI, we believe that it is important to promote and bring today's youth on the front foot for the development at ground zero by involving them in policy-making and governance. It is indeed crucial to provide a platform and strategize development in target constituencies thereby making them an Ideal Parliamentary Constituency.

## Overview of Young Leaders Program

GGI's Young Leaders Program (YLP) is designed to spread awareness and impart knowledge on the concept of UNSDGs linking with India's Vision 2030. The YLP focuses on implementation of 17 Goals through various government schemes and how governance can be transformed with the usage of Sustainable Development Goals.

**A month-long program shall briefly focus on the following: –**

- **Week 1** – Orientation and Learning Sessions of 40 minutes duration taken by GGI Team Leads, Ministerial Administrators and Professionals. Each Session will give an insight on particular SDGs focusing on “**United Nations' 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development by incorporating it in India's Vision 2030**”.
- **Week 2** – Interactive Webinars on Sustainable Development Goals with experience sharing by Parliamentarians & Bureaucrats.
- **Week 3** – Task assignment by Team Leads (Research Papers/ Idea Sharing/ Group Discussions)
- **Week 4** – Talk Show with speakers from Government of India, NITI Aayog, UNDP India, UN India, Permanent Mission of India, New York. Concluding session along with announcement of best researchers and speakers.



## Eligibility

- An individual aged between 15– 24 years.
- Interested in social & community development.

## Duration

- 1st October, 2020 – 31st October, 2020
- 30 Sessions – Per day for 40–45 Minutes.

## Benefit

- One–month Participation Certificate by GGI to participants.
- Appreciation Certificate by Member of Parliament – 2 Best Young Leaders chosen from each SDG group, who gives best research inputs during task assignments.
- 1 Month Virtual Internship Opportunity in Office of Parliamentarians – 1 Best Young Leader from each SDG group, who enthusiastically participates in task assignments and comes out with innovative ideas.
- Letter of Recommendation for Foreign Studies – 3 best Young Leaders, who actively attends and participates along with effective & efficient ideas put forward in all 30 sessions.

**Note:** Each Session shall be presided by an Honorary Member of GGIs Advisory Board, who shall be marking Young Leaders during Task Assignments Sessions.
