# **Lex Communiqué – 2021**

## **National Debate Competition**

### **(Vidhi Chhatra Sansad)**

LEX COMMUNIQUE is a National Law Fest of Thakur Ramnarayan College of Law. Its “National Debate Competition” is an initiative to engage youth in healthy discourse and expose them to current events, topics in national relations, diplomacy and concerning agendas.

#### • **ELIGIBILITY:**

- Students enrolled in 3 year or 5-year law course.
- Participants must enroll in teams/groups of 2 students.
- Passionate about current issues.

#### • **RULES AND REGULATIONS:**

1. Each participating team shall prepare for sides, i.e., the proponent and opponent.
2. The competition shall be held in three rounds- Preliminary, Semi-Finals & Final.
3. Best six teams from Preliminary round shall qualify for Semi-Final Round and the best two teams of the Semi-Final Round shall qualify for the Final Round
4. The team combinations for Semi-Final and Final round (which team will compete against whom) shall be decided by draw of lots on the day of the event.
5. Each team Shall speak for five minutes in preliminary round, ten minutes in Semi-final round and 15 minutes in the Final round.
6. There will be negative marking for teams exceeding the allotted time.
7. Speakers are allowed to speak in English only.

8. The result of the Preliminary Round will be announced on 13<sup>th</sup> March 2021.  
Participating team has to prepare five minutes video and email us on [vcs@trcl.org.in](mailto:vcs@trcl.org.in) by 10<sup>th</sup> March 2021.
9. Semi-Final Round will be held on 13<sup>th</sup> March 2021.
10. Final Round will be conducted live on 14<sup>th</sup> March 2021.
11. No abusive language or gesture shall be used, it will lead to disqualification.
12. Decision of the judges shall be final, and no objection shall be entertained.
13. The organizers can make any changes relating to the rules of the event.
