Guidelines for Submission

Center for Social Sciences at School of Law, Bennett University, is in the process of publishing the third issue of its annual magazine: The Tenet. Hence, we invite everyone to be a part of the same by submitting their work for publication in the magazine. The theme for this year's Tenet issue is **Debunking Youth Mental Health**. Students and Scholars may submit their works in following format:

- Articles
- Poems
- Posters
- Opinions

Following are the guidelines for sending your work to the magazine:

1. General Submission Guidelines

- a. Students are free to choose their topics in accordance with the theme of the magazine. It is recommended that controversial topics be avoided altogether, or the authors approach them cautiously. The authors are required to have a creative academic approach towards their topics.
- b. Plagiarism beyond 5% will automatically disqualify the draft from getting published in the magazine.
- c. If students submit pictures or any other art, it must be a completely original work.
- d. Center for Social Sciences reserves the right to reject/accept the submission for publications as per the requirements and the quality of the submissions.
- e. The submission **deadline is 3rd April 2022**.

Note that any submission after the deadlines will not be entertained.

2. Submission Guidelines for Articles

- a. Word limit for Article is **800 to 1000** words. If appreciated writing exceeds the word limit, then it will be sent back to author for revision.

- b. The font of the submission must be Times New Roman, Size 14 for the front page, 12 for the article, and size 10 for footnote, line spacing 1.5 and the entire draft must be justified. Co-authorship **up to two authors** is permitted.
- c. The students are requested to mention the following in their drafts:
 - Title of the work
 - Name
 - Enrolment Number
 - Batch and Section
 - Email ID
 - Phone Number
 - Declaration of Originality
- d. The authors are required to submit sources for the facts mentioned in their articles in the form of footnoting. The citation style may be in any form.
- e. The final articles must be mailed at: Centerforsocialsciences.bu@gmail.com

3. Submission Guidelines for Poem

- a. Word limit for poems is **500 words**. The poems have to be student's original work. Plagiarized poems will be automatically disqualified.
- b. The font of the submission has to be Times New Roman, Size 12 for the content and Size 14 for the front page.
- c. Students are supposed to submit their drafts with the following mentioning:
 - Title of the work
 - Name
 - Enrolment Number
 - Batch and Section
 - Email ID
 - Phone Number
 - Declaration of Originality
- d. The final poem must be mailed at: Centerforsocialsciences.bu@gmail.com

4. Submission Guidelines for Poster

- a. Posters must be submitted in **.jpg or .png format only**. Posters should be an original creation of the student. The declaration of originality must be attached separately along with the details of the student.
- b. Poster should reflect the theme of the magazine.
- c. The final posters must be mailed at: Centerforsocialsciences.bu@gmail.com

5. Submission Guidelines for Opinion

- a. Word limit for opinions is **200 words**. It is suggested that the opinions should be apolitical. The font of the submission has to be Times New Roman, Size 12 for the content.
- b. Students, who want to maintain their identity anonymous in the magazine, must mention the same in their write up.
- c. The students are requested to mention the following in their drafts:
 - Title of the work
 - Name
 - Enrolment Number
 - Batch and Section
 - Email ID
 - Phone Number
 - Declaration of Originality
- d. The final drafts must be mailed at: Centerforsocialsciences.bu@gmail.com
