GUIDELINES FOR SUBMISSION

1. All submissions shall be uploaded on the form [here](#).
2. By submitting an article, the author undertakes that the article is an original work and has not been submitted, accepted or published elsewhere.
3. Co-authorship is not allowed.
4. Plagiarism will result in summary rejection of the submission.
5. Length of the article must not exceed 1500 words.
6. All submissions must be in English. The content should be written in Times New Roman font, with size 12 and line spacing 1.5.
7. All references must be in the form of hyperlinks in the body of the submission. In case no hyperlink is available for any reference, the use of endnotes is recommended. All endnotes must be in Times New Roman font, with size 10 and line spacing 1.
8. Submissions must be made in .doc/.docx formats only.
9. Entries not abiding by the above instructions will not be accepted.

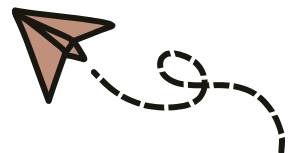
